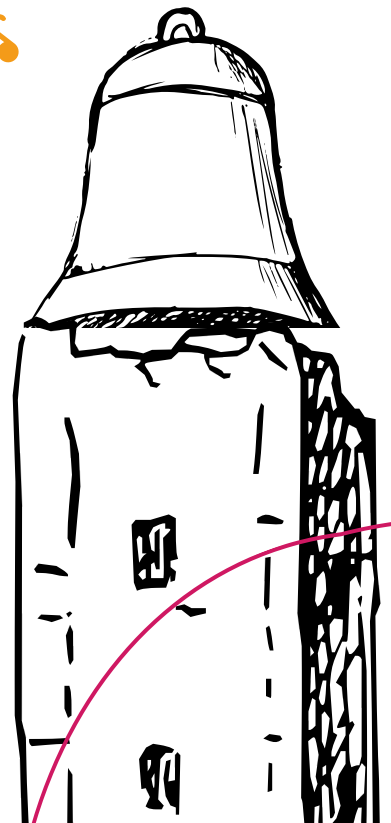
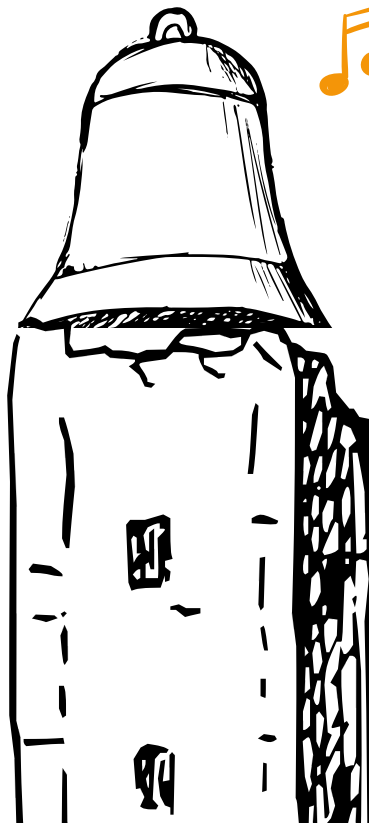

What can you see atop of them?



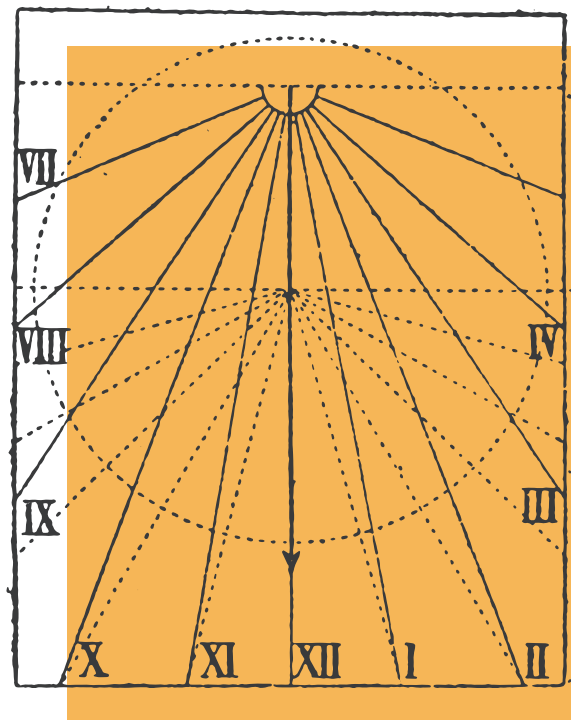

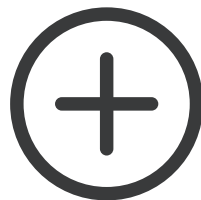

The "Comminges" cross



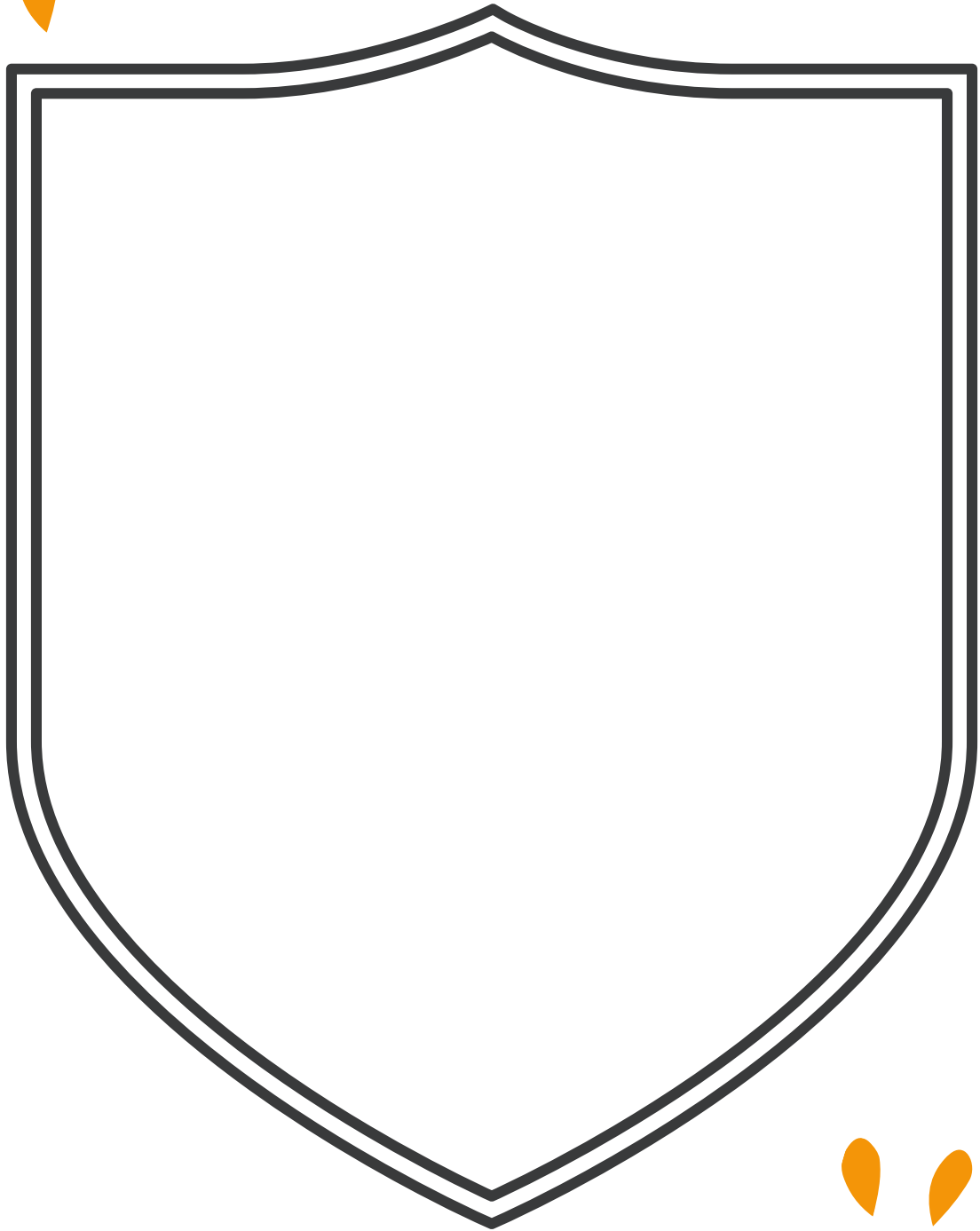
As you journey to the "Comminges" Square, you hear a murmur coming from the Passion Cross. Examine it with a keen eye... What animal is portrayed?

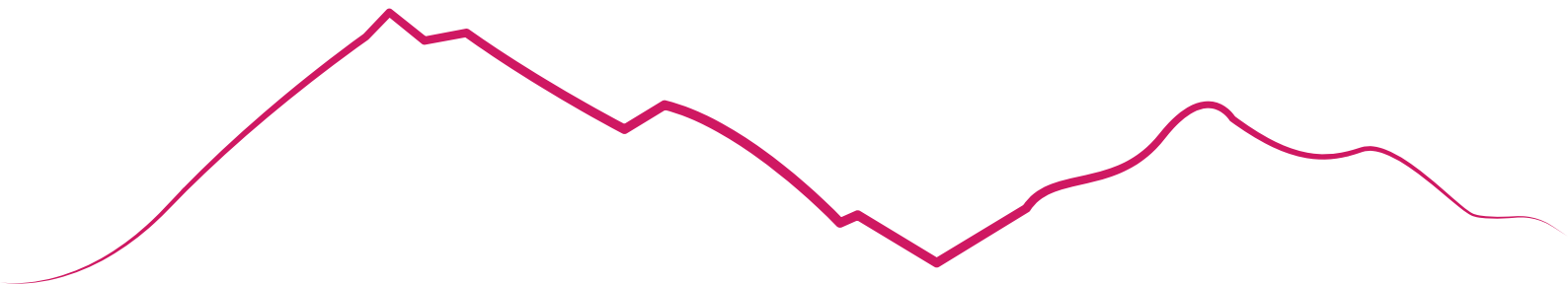
