- ☐ A baron



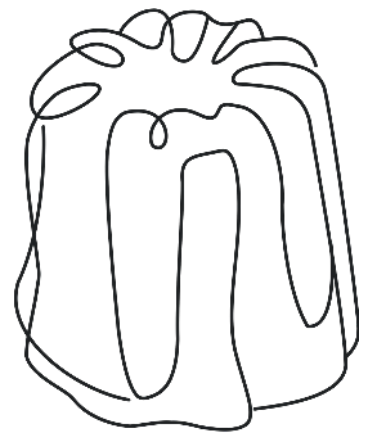
A Drop of Wisdom:

The title of baron is a mark of nobility, bestowed by the hand of the king.

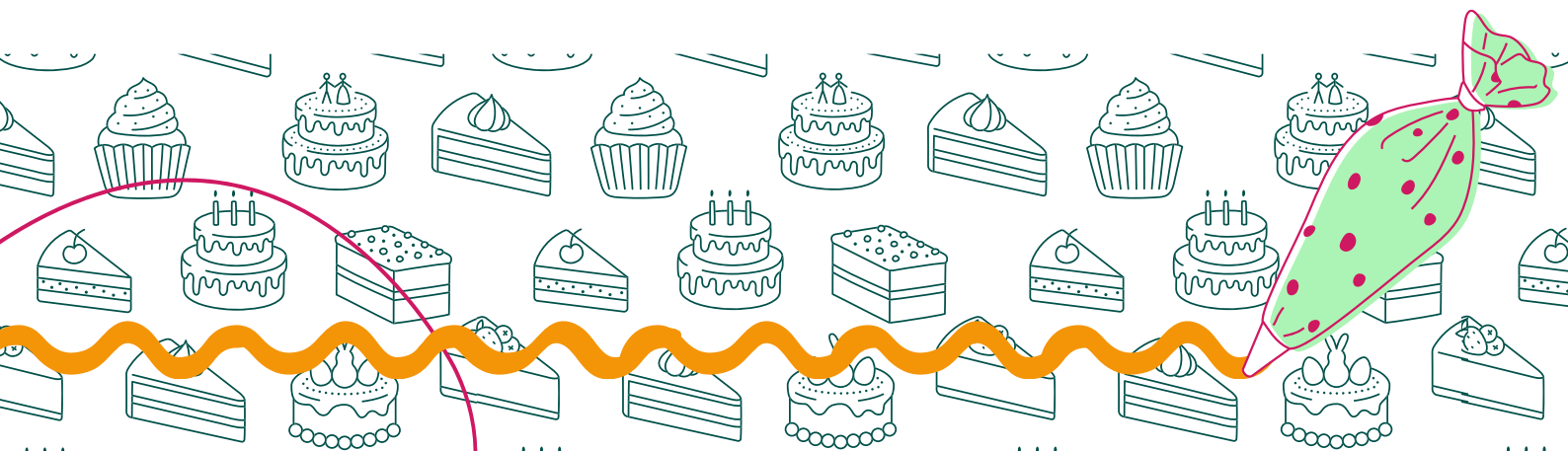


Suberbielle's bakery

 How long has it been delighting travelers and townsfolk alike?



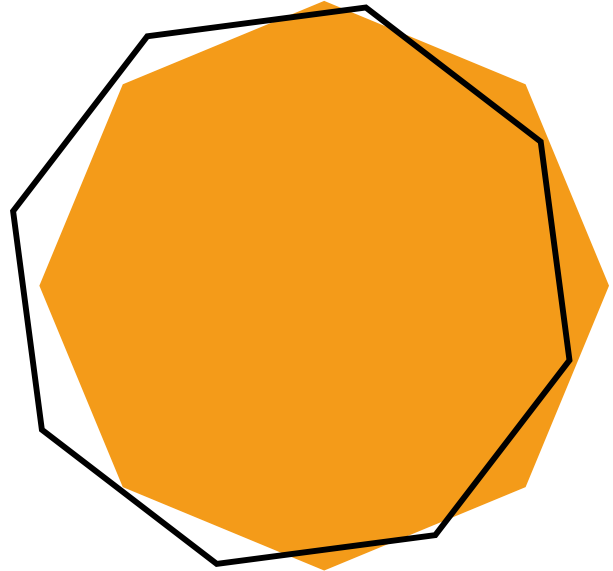
The Livestock Market Hall

What's the name of the river that unfolds before your eyes?

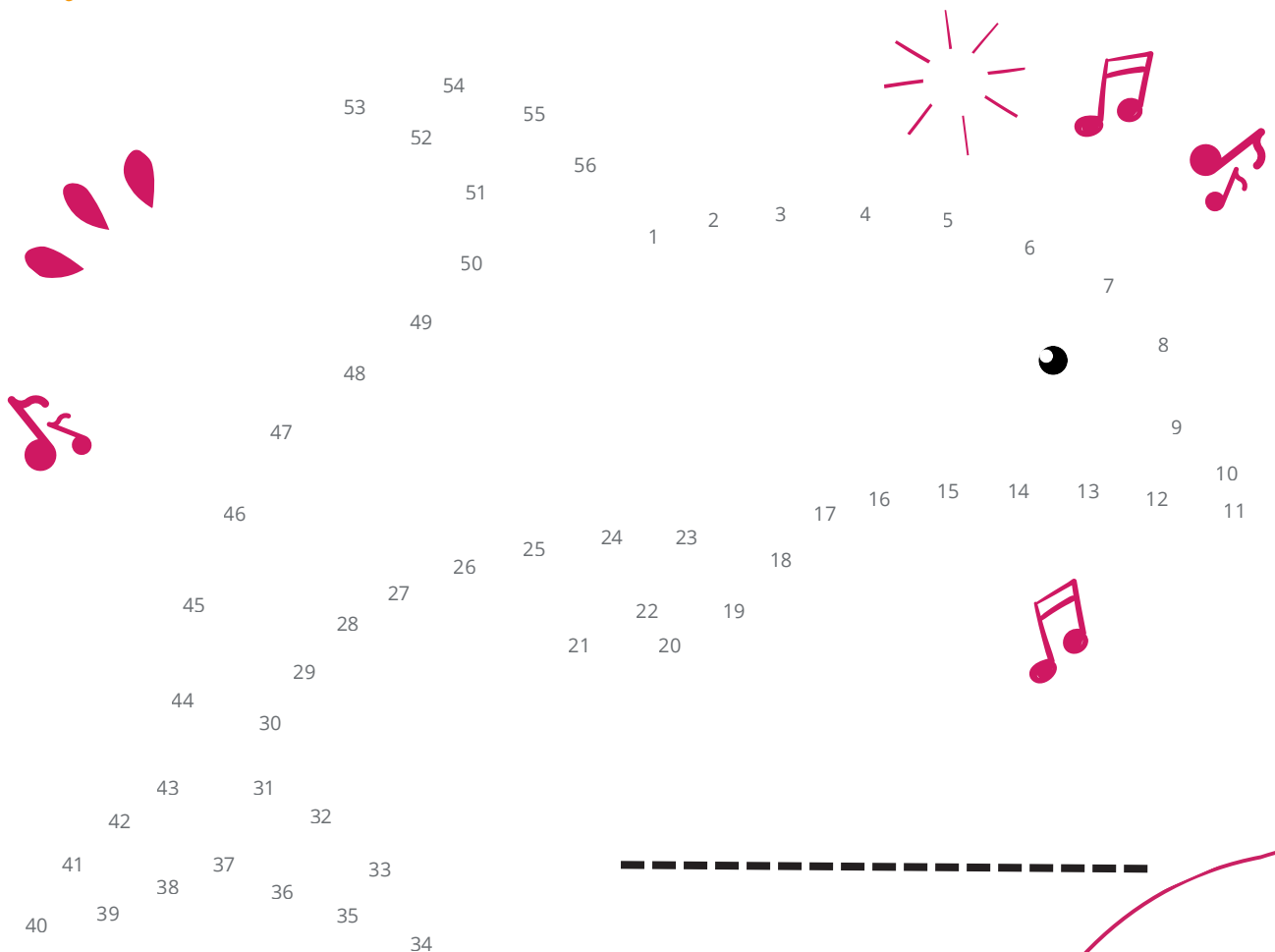

Before you stands lord Bertrand de Lassus, the kind benefactor of these lands.



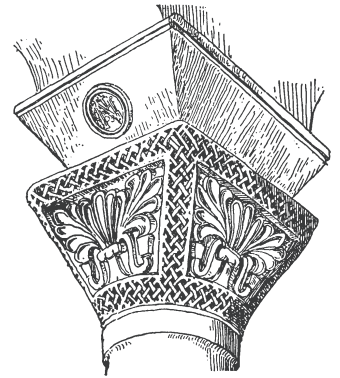
Examine it with a keen eye... What's he holding on his right arm?

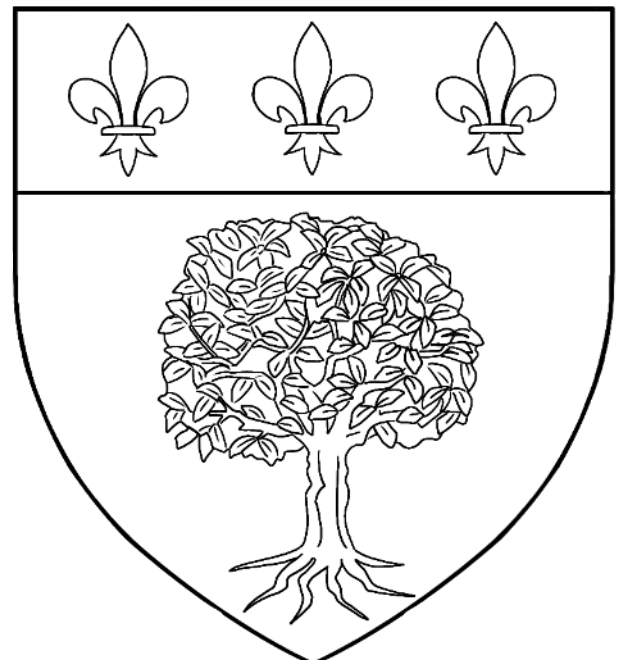

"Valentin Abeille" Square



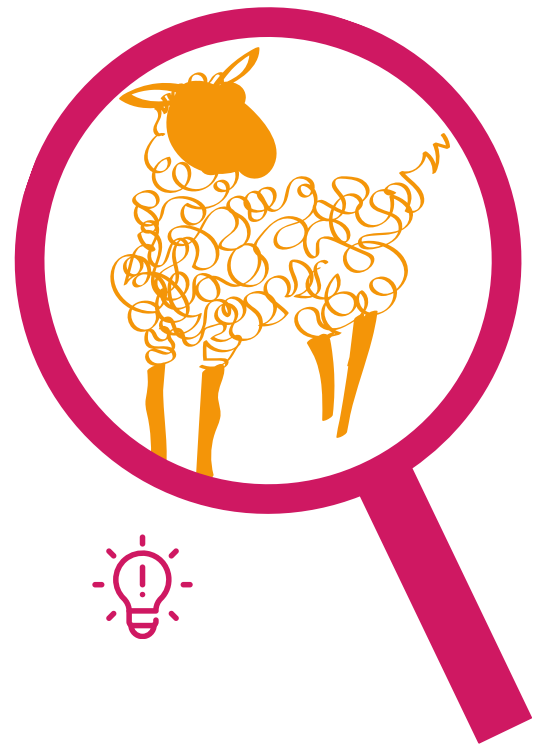
As you retrace your steps to Valentin Abeille Square, make your way to the statue of Saint John the Baptist ! At his feet hides a curious creature...

I'm not a sheep, but I'm never far from one.

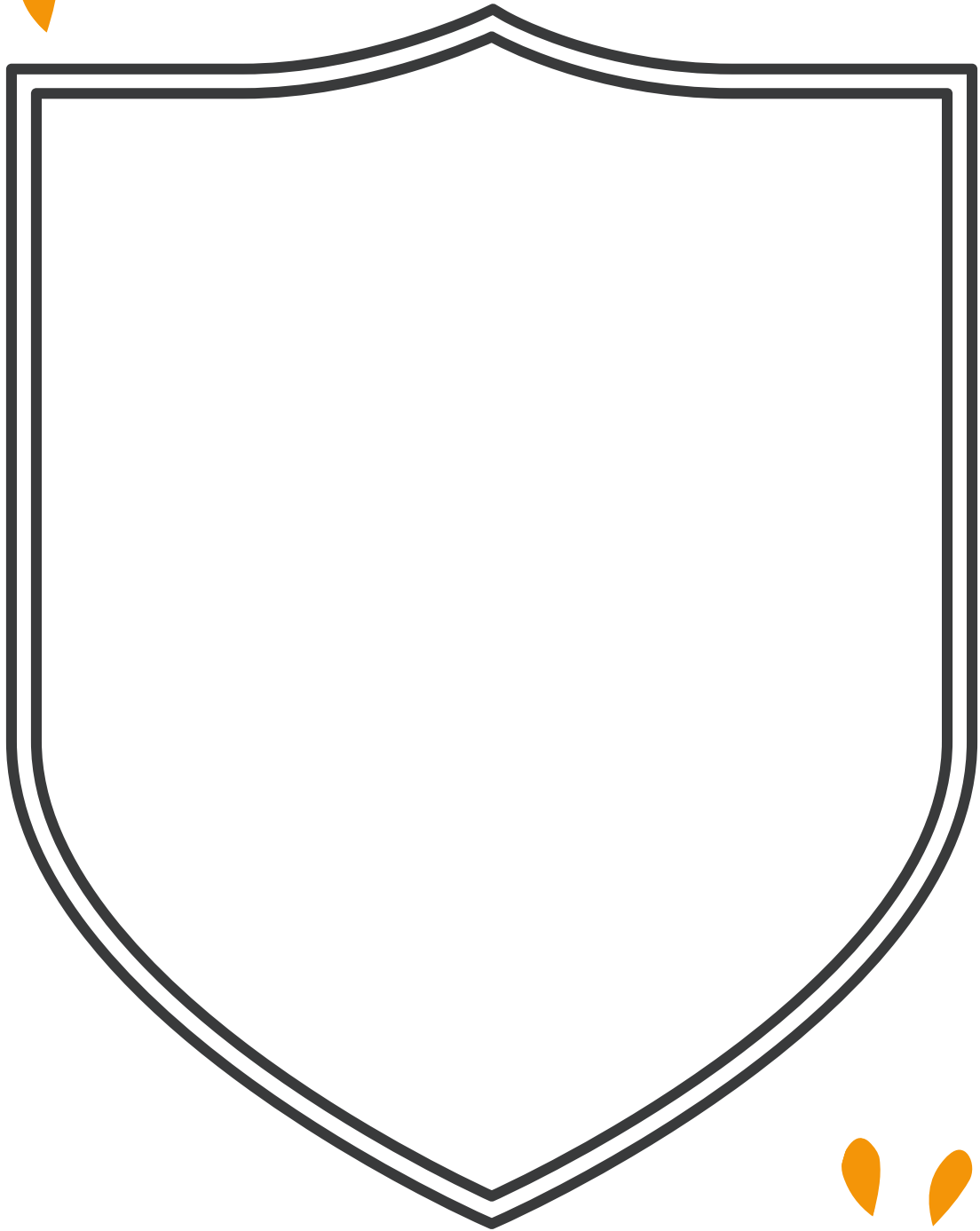
And the shepherd watches over me, day and night.

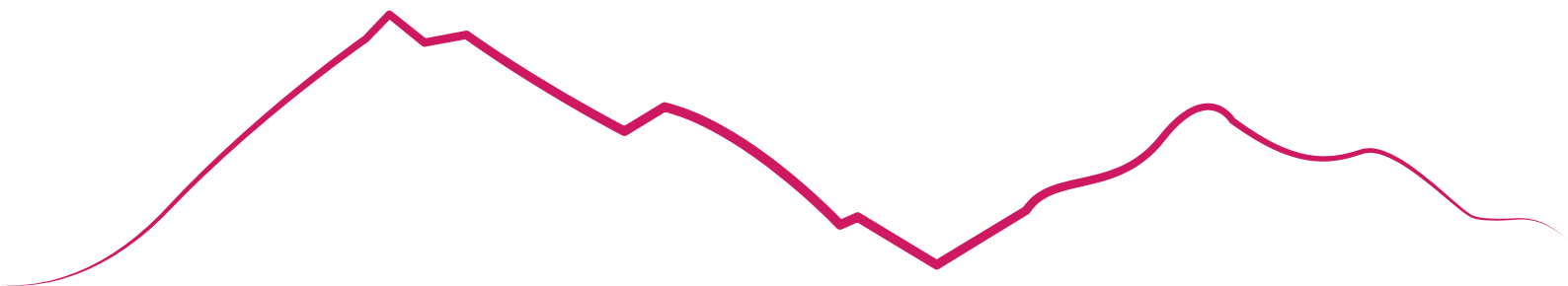
